



Dr. med. Maren Kleine-Brueggene

After studying medicine at the University of Witten/ Herdecke in Germany, Maren Kleine-Brueggene specialized in anaesthesia at the University Hospital in Bern and at the Spital Region Oberaargau in Langenthal, Switzerland.

She worked as a research fellow at the University Hospital of Bern in Switzerland, where she obtained her medical doctoral degree. Her main research interests are clinical airway management, postoperative nausea and vomiting and coagulation.
