Following her study in medicine at the University of Gazi, Ankara, Turkey Dr. Ayten Saracoglu specialized in anaesthesiology and reanimation at Istanbul Marmara University School of Medicine. Following an observer fellowship at Jena University, Germany, she became an assistant professor at the Medical University of Istanbul Bilim in 2012. In 2015 she was promoted to associate professor at the same University.
